

Creative " gift idea " Christmas Concert

Working time: 4 Minutes

With this miniature gift set, you can create an atmospheric concert scene as a Christmas gift in no time. Inside the small box, a wintry miniature world with sparkling accents takes shape—one that you can lovingly decorate and fill with your own touches. This turns a cash gift or " Voucher " into a personal surprise with a special wow factor. Ideal for beginners who want quick, neat results when crafting.

Make a "Concert" Miniature Gift Set as a Christmas Miniature Box

First, fold the box along all the pre-scored edges, then glue it together neatly. This step ensures that your miniature scene will stand sturdily later on and that the interior surfaces can be covered smoothly with adhesive.

Paint the interior black—for a stage-like feel

Paint the inside of the box with black " handicraft paint. " The dark background creates a stage-like effect and will make the miniatures stand out more later on. Let the paint dry completely so nothing smudges as you continue working and the glued surfaces hold securely.

Add the background and floor—this gives the scene depth

Design the floor and background of the stage using motif photo cardboard: Cut a piece of "floor" and a piece of "wooden wall panel" to fit into the box as a back wall and/or floor. Glue both pieces into the box using " handicraft glue ." A neatly installed background immediately gives your miniature diorama box more depth and the feel of a "real" space.

Add Points of Light – Create a Festive Atmosphere

Attach small round " metallic-" stickers to the inside walls of the box. Space them out strategically so they look like twinkling lights.

test tube Fill it – wrap a cash gift in style

Fill the " test tube ," for example, with money or a " Voucher. " Roll up the bills tightly so they fit snugly inside, then seal it securely again. This way, the miniature gift set becomes not just a decoration, but a practical Christmas gift with an element of surprise.

Arrange and Secure the Miniatures—So Nothing Slips

Now place all the miniatures in the box as desired and quickly check how they look before gluing them down. If you're happy with the arrangement, glue the pieces in place. Securing them is important so that the miniature box remains stable during transport or when given as a gift, and so your little concert scene still looks exactly the same later on as it did when you were making it.

Fine-tuning for a clean finish

Finally, check the edges and glued areas. Remove any small glue residue right away while it's still soft, and gently press all the elements into place once more. This will ensure your miniature money gift looks neat and high-quality —perfect as a Christmas gift this winter.

Ready to Give
