

# Crocheted wool poufs Boston

Instructions No. 1365

Difficulty: Advanced 

With the help of this **original crocheting instruction from Schachenmayr** even untrained **crocheters** can quickly make **large** seat cushions from the classic Boston wool. These will surely be the new optical highlights in your home!

## And this is how it is done

The seat cushions are first **crocheted** with **Boston wool**.

**For the ticking, Cotton fabric is sewn tighter.** The manufacturer recommends sewing an 80 cm long zipper in this ticking. Alternatively, self-adhesive Velcro strap can be used.

### Extra tip:

The fabric for the ticking should be matched to the wool colour chosen. Choose a Cotton fabric of your choice from our wide range - our plain cotton fabrics **are all of** very high quality and are perfect for pillow inserts.
